# AP EXAMS

### What are they?

- Advanced Placement (AP) examinations are taken each May as the culmination of year-long AP courses. Like the SAT and subject tests, AP exams are published by College Board.
- ▶ STEM offers the following AP classes and exams:
  - \* AP US History
  - AP Chemistry
  - AP Calculus AB
  - AP Literature
- Anyone taking an AP class is required to take the AP exam for that class.

#### Why should I take them?

▶ They can earn you college credit or placement.

Scores of 4 and 5 show that you have mastered college level work and bolster your applications.

## How are they scored?

▶ On a 1-5 scale.

Scores of 3 and higher are considered passing.

We recommend submitting scores of 4 & 5 when you apply for college.

# How do I sign up and pay for AP exams?

- Students register for exams in March in their classrooms.
- STEM pays for students to take the AP exams.
