A-4 Approval of implementation of the District's 21st CCLC Community Learning Centers grant program

RESOLVED, that the Receiver, acting as the Board of School Directors approve the implementation of the District's 21st CCLC Community Learning Centers grant program to provide supplemental after school activities including ELA, STEM-based, arts, mentoring, and other enrichment. Programming is designed to support and complement CUSD's instructional initiatives, increase student academic achievement, decrease regression and assist with social growth and development. Programming will operate from October 2020 – June 2021.

Programming costs:

- Building Level Coordinators \$40/hr.
- Teaching staff at \$32/hr.
- Guidance Staff/Social Workers to implement college/career readiness and social emotional wellness at \$32/hr.
- Climate Managers to implement violence prevention/social emotional wellness at \$25/hr.
- Teaching Assistants at \$15/hr.
- Contracted services for enrichment services and family engagement
- Materials and supplies

Cost: Not to exceed \$250.000

A-5 Approval for Teaching Learning Succeeding LLC to provide Professional development

RESOLVED, that the Receiver, acting as the Board of School Directors, grant approval for Teaching Learning Succeeding, LLC (TLC) to provide professional development focused on the planning and delivery of engaging Remote Learning strategies. The structure of these programs is based on the following research-based principles:

- (1) Learner Relationships: building connections; student-student, student-content, teacher-families, student-teacher
- (2) Curriculum Clarity: being clear on your essential content, depth versus breadth
- (3) Assessment Driven Instruction: the use of ongoing assessment to respond to student needs so all are engaged at the correct level of difficulty. TLS promotes Assessment Driven, Responsive, and Engaging Instruction.
- (4) Reflection and Feedback: Celebrating growth, troubleshoot and seek support

The Remote Learning Courses are structured in three Stages to meet teacher needs:

- Stage 1: Setting the Foundation for Remote Learning
- Stage 2: How to Engage Learners and Sustain Remote Learning
- Stage 3: Innovate and Expand Remote Learning

As part of this Agreement, TLS will provide coaching and administrative support and professional learning on how to supervise remote instruction. TLS will continue to provide professional development on differentiated instruction, assessment, instructional coaching, classroom

management, critical thinking, standards based instruction, and organizational planning to STEM Academy's administrators and teachers throughout the 2020-21 school year. Teachers will be afforded the opportunity and guidance to successfully engage students in innovative teaching practices such as flexible grouping, individualized instruction, and effective use of technology in the classroom. TLS's prescribed methodology will help provide teachers with recommendations to effectively meet the needs of all learners in the class through flexible grouping and differentiated instruction as applicable to maximize their potential and demonstrate growth in academic areas.

Primary goals include:

- enhancing teachers' ability to integrate effective formative assessment and data analysis to drive instruction;
- increasing instructional acuity—knowing when and how to differentiate;
- developing a well-stocked strategy toolbox to draw from when "some students get it and some do not";
- managing a variety of instructional settings. In addition, TLS will provide professional learning for the Administrative Team on supervising for Differentiated Instruction with use of technology in a virtual setting.
